Vision - To strengthen the South West Pacific – by developing effective junior leaders and strong future networks. Through facilitating a community of connection, culture, experiential development, adventure, and leading by example, while developing capacity.

Our Pacific Student Leaders Programme is a week-long course that sees young people from across New Zealand, Australia and the Pacific Islands come together to develop their personal and team leadership skills through fun, unique, hands-on activities.

The course kicks off on **Friday 10th (Australian Students) and Saturday 11th April 2026 (NZ students),** with all students flying to **Rarotonga** from **Auckland** and **Sydney** International Airports. You'll meet the local **Cook Islands** based students also attending the course once we arrive. While there you will be in smaller groups (syndicates) getting around the island by van. The course will take place over seven days, where you'll complete a range of exercises designed to develop your leadership skills; such as communication, collaboration and strategic thinking. These exercises will range from group work and discussions to hands-on, practical exercises, with each student having the chance to lead their syndicate multiple times. Scenarios will focus on business, tourism, survival, conservation, the environment and more.

ABOUT OUR TEAM

Led by our Course Manager, the Future Leaders Academy team is made up of leadership instructors and youth mentors. All instructors have youth development experience, and are experts at delivering our training in a way that is safe, interactive, engaging and meaningful for our students. PROGRAMME DETAILS

The course runs from **Saturday 11th (Friday 10th for Aussies) - Sunday 19th Apr 2026**, including travel.

Rarotonga is 4 hours ahead of AEST Australia time and 2 hours behind New Zealand, minus one day. Please note travel dates and times will state which country's time zone this is in. Our team will work with each student to help organise your connections to our international flights.

FLIGHTS

Please note: flights will be confirmed approximately 10 months prior to travel. We recommend that you do not book your domestic travel until these are confirmed.

NZ Students only

NZ students will need to book and pay for your own travel to/from your home to the **Auckland International Airport**, and let us know your domestic travel arrangements. Our staff will meet you at the Akld airport and travel with the group to **Rarotonga** and return.

NZ Students International Flights to/from Raro:

- Sat 11th Apr, depart Auckland, 3:10pm, Jetstar (JQ115). Arrive Raro, Fri 10th, 9.05pm.
- Fri 17th Apr, depart Raro, 10:00pm, Jetstar (JQ114). Arrive Auckland, Sun 19th Apr, 12:35am.

NZ Student Domestic Travel to Auckland Airport

All students will need to arrange their own domestic travel within New Zealand to connect with the departure and arrival times of the international flights above. For departure on 11th Apr 2025 – Please ensure you arrive at Auckland Airport by 12pm. This allows for plenty of time to arrive, meet the rest of our group and check in.

For returning home, once we've arrived back in Auckland – please aim for a flight departure, if needed, on the 19th Apr, after 10am & before 12pm. The group will overnight at the IBIS Auckland Airport hotel, due to arriving in the early hours. For IBIS Collections check out time is 10.00am.

We strongly recommend booking flexi fares if you are flying domestically which will cover most costs to change flights if needed. Flight changes and delays are often out of our control but are a very common risk (due to weather) with travel and one we encounter regularly. **FLA will not be liable for your domestic flight changes or if our international dates/times change.**

A detailed Travel-Plan will be created with all students' confirmed domestic travel times for staff to monitor and will assist your family if alternative arrangements must be made due to delays or cancellations.

We will have FLA staff members stationed at the Auckland Domestic Terminal in the morning to meet you and transfer you across to Auckland International Airport.

If you are being dropped off to the Auckland airport please go directly to the International Airport terminal by **12.00pm** NZT where some of our FLA staff will be stationed. Our staff will be in blue or green FLA polo shirts. Meeting spots are often near the check in counter area, but we'll confirm closer to the time.

AUS Students only

Australian students will need to book and pay for your own travel to/from **Sydney** International Airport, and let us know your domestic travel arrangements. One of our staff will meet you at the **Sydney** airport and travel with the group to **Raro** and return. On a caseby-case, students can choose to travel from another international airport.

Aus Students International Flights to/from Raro

- Fri 10th Apr, depart Sydney, 9:30pm, Jetstar (JQ113). Arrive Raro, Fri 10th, 7:30am.
- Fri 17th Apr, depart Raro, 10:00pm, Jetstar (JQ114). Arrive Auckland, Sun 19th Apr, 12:35am.
- Sun 19th Apr, depart Auckland, 12.40pm, Jetstar (JQ204). Arrive Sydney, 2.30pm.

Aus Student domestic travel to Sydney Airport

All students will need to arrange their own domestic travel within Australia to connect with the departure and arrival times of the international flights above. If you are flying into **Sydney** you need to have enough buffer time in case your flight is delayed. **For departure on 10th Apr 2026 – Please ensure you arrive at Sydney Airport no later than 7:00pm AEST.** This allows for plenty of time to arrive, meet the rest of our group and check in for our international departure.

For returning home, once we've arrived back in Sydney – please aim for a flight departure, if needed, on the 19th Apr, after 4.30pm. For transiting through Auckland, the group will overnight at the IBIS Auckland Airport hotel, due to arriving in the early hours.

We strongly recommend booking flexi fares if you are flying domestically which will cover most costs to change flights if needed. Flight changes and delays are often out of our control but are a very common risk with travel and one we encounter regularly. **FLA will not be liable for your domestic flight changes or if our international dates/times change.**

A detailed Travel-Plan will be created with all students' confirmed domestic travel times for staff to monitor and will assist your family if alternative arrangements must be made due to delays or cancellations.

We will have an FLA staff member stationed at the **Sydney** International Terminal to meet you.

If you are being dropped off to the **Sydney** airport please go directly to the International Airport terminal by **7:00pm** AEST. Our staff will be in blue or green FLA uniforms. Meeting spots are often near the check in area, but we'll confirm closer to the time.

Baggage

Your ticket allows one piece of checked in baggage, with a weight of up to 20kg. Please note: If you are traveling on a domestic flight prior to your international flight, your luggage allowance may be different, so make sure you check your baggage allowance. You are also allowed one piece of cabin baggage, weighing up to 7kg.

Travel Requirements + Documents

TRAVEL / MEDICAL INSURANCE

Your international travel insurance, with cancellation cover, is included in your fees. Insurance is arranged by Future Leaders Academy, with ALLIANZ Insurance, as part of our group travel policy. **Details of insurance are available on our** <u>T&C's page</u>.

Payment Details

Paying your course fee – unless you've already paid in full.

A \$495 deposit is required to secure your space on the programme. The remaining fee is split into 2 instalment dates for payment. You will receive 2 invoices via email with the required due dates. You are welcome to make smaller payments towards your invoice as you receive funds and before the due date and we will keep you updated with remaining due amount for payment.

If you would like to put a weekly / fortnightly / monthly payment plan in place, please contact us to discuss once you have paid your deposit payment. Final and full payment must be made 12 weeks prior to the course.

Please ensure that your invoices are paid on time or agreed payment plans are adhered to. We will not commit to booking your international flights (non-refundable) if your fees are not paid.

Refunds, participant cancellations & departures policy

Your remaining course fee, not your deposit, is refundable up to twelve weeks before your course start date. If you cancel within twelve weeks of your course starting, your full course fee is not refundable, but is transferable. Cancellations must be received in writing by email.

If a medical reason prevents you from joining the course, you will need to claim the course fees back through travel insurance.

If you depart for any reason, including behaviour, motivation barriers, injury or illness incurred on course, you will not receive a refund. You must contact our travel insurance provider for any claims.

If something major happens outside our control e.g; natural disaster, international flight departure delays longer than two days, or any other significant operational issue preventing the safe and effective delivery of a programme, we might have to cancel the trip.

Future Leaders reserves the right to amend dates or make changes to courses, if necessary. This could be due to not meeting the minimum number of students enrolled, or other operational reasons. Paying your deposit is your agreement to our T&Cs.

STUDENT AND PARENT/CAREGIVER DETAILS & CONSENT

If you are under 18 years of age at the time of applying for your course, we are required to obtain parental consent for you to travel with us and attend this programme. Your parent or caregiver will need to provide their consent on the Online Consent Form, which you'll find as a link in your confirmation email once your deposit has been paid. Please complete and submit the online form within seven days of receiving it.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation is on the main town of **Avarua**, **Rarotonga**. The activities take place in various places across the island. We will be staying as a group in shared hostel style accommodation.

We recommend packing ear plugs and an eye mask if you are a light sleeper!

Male and female accommodation will be separated.

MEALS

All main meals and snacks will be provided during the course. Meals will include a balanced range of nutritious foods and beverages. Staff and students will share in the meal preparation during the programme.

Please be aware that menus on this programme will be reflective of the cultural cuisines and may differ to what you may be used to at home. We will endeavour to meet all dietary needs and restrictions however this will be within the resources available to us there.

Dietary requirements

Ensure you include any special dietary requirements on the Student Information and Consent Form.

What To Bring – Packing List

Below is a list of the basic clothing and equipment you will need to bring with you. This list may be updated and we will be in touch again closer to the time if there is anything to add to this:

- Comfortable active wear (shorts x3, T-shirts x3) You will be given a FLA T-shirt to wear, which you will wear for most activities.
- Comfortable running shoes (essential), jandals/flip flops/sandals, dress shoes (optional), reef shoes (optional/if you have them)
- Semi formal outfit for final celebration dinner ie, Dress shirt/blouse, dress pants/skirt
- Set of summer style evening wear (nice shorts, polo/casual shirt, dress)
- Rain jacket (lightweight is okay)
- Togs/bathers
- Sunhat
- 2x Towels
- Underwear
- Toiletries
 - \circ Including sanitary products, shampoo & conditioner, toothpaste etc
- Any medication you may need
 - Please ensure you list this in the detailed medical action plan as described in the Student Information & Consent form.
 - Light pain relief such as panadol or ibuprofen if you are prone to headaches etc. *NB: FLA will have first aid kits also*
- Camera/phone
- Sunscreen (plenty of it!), Insect repellent, after sun.
- Drink bottle (reusable drink bottle to keep hydrated)
- Container to put packed lunches in.
- Optional: Ear plugs and an eye mask for optimal undisturbed sleep.

All the main travel, accommodation and course costs including your meals and snacks each day are covered by your course fee and Future Leaders Academy. We would recommend bringing some cash or local currency, approx \$50-\$100, with you if you'd like to have a little bit of money for any personal spending (postcards, ice-creams etc).

Medical Emergencies

Minor medical situations will be treated by an FLA staff member, who are all first aid trained, and have our own comprehensive first aid kits. If a more serious medical event occurs students will be taken to **Rarotonga Hospital**, which has an emergency department.

Communications

Communication closer to the course date and during the course will be made through WHATSAPP. If you don't have the WhatsApp app, please install it to your device. You will receive an invite to join the group once this has been set up.

All Future Leaders Academy staff will have a mobile phone with internet access, as well as a Data Pack. Students are welcome to use these mobile phones at the end of the day, to ensure contact with family back home if wanted.

Most mobile phone providers from NZ/Aus will allow you to use your phone overseas (roaming) for a reasonable price. Please check with your phone provider before travelling, for accurate roaming information. Students may also like to purchase their own local SIM card.

NOTE: Access to using all mobile phones will be restricted at certain times, including during meal times.
